

Dr. Jordi Esquena studied Chemistry at the Autonomous University of Barcelona (Spain) and he carried out his Ph.D research, in 1996, in the Chemical and Environmental Research Institute of Barcelona (IIQAB), now denominated Institute for Advanced Chemistry of Catalonia (IQAC), which belongs to the Spanish Council of Scientific research (CSIC). After a 3-year post-doctoral stay in the University of Hull (U.K.), he joined the IIQAB (IQAC) in 2000, where he is a member of research staff since 2006. His research interests include the formulation of novel colloidal systems, the preparation of nanostructured materials by using colloidal systems as templates, and more recently, the study of formation and stabilization of novel Water-in-Water (W/W) emulsions and their use for the formation of microgels, and encapsulation and delivery of active components.
