Keith is Senior Lecturer in Urban Studies at the University of Glasgow . He was Head of Urban Studies and Deputy Head of the School of Social and Political Sciences from 2010-2013.

Keith was born in Elgin, Scotland and educated at Universities of Sussex and Edinburgh. He is a Member of the Chartered Institute of Housing, a Chartered Town Planner, and an elected Fellow of the UK Academy of Social Sciences.
