Patrick Pageat one of the founders of the IRSEA. born on 10 Decembre 10th, 1960 in Villepinte (France). He obtained his Vet Degree at the National Veterinary School of Lyon, in 1983. In 1985, he obtained a Master Degree in Entomology and Insect Physiology.

In 1991, he achieved his PhD, at the Museum National d'Histoire Naturelle (Paris) with a thesis on the predatoryl behaviour of the digger wasp *Philanthus triangulum* (which paralyses honeybees to feed its larvae). He created the Consultation of Behavioural Medicine at the National Veterinary School of Lyon, in 1983 and then at the National Veterinary School of Maisons Alfort in 1985, with the support of Professor Moraillon.

In 1995, he publishes « Pathologie du Comportement du Chien » (Canine Behavioural pathology). The book was reedited in 1999 and translated in Italian and Spanish. In 1996 he in one of the co-founders of the European Society of Veterinary Clinical Ethology and in 1998 of the European College of Companion Animals Behavioural Medicine (ECVBM-CA) which will become, during his presidency, European College of Animal Welfare and Behavioural Medicine (ECAWBM).

After 8 years of a professional activity associating clinical activity, teaching and research, he created Phérosynthèse in 1995, with Hugues Lucas de Leyssac. Within this Institut which has since become the IRSEA, he has applied for over 200 patents.

Other than his functions at the IRSEA, he is Associate Professor in Applied Ethology and Animal Welfare at the E.I. Purpan and invited Professor at the Veterinary Faculties of Barcelona and Pisa.
